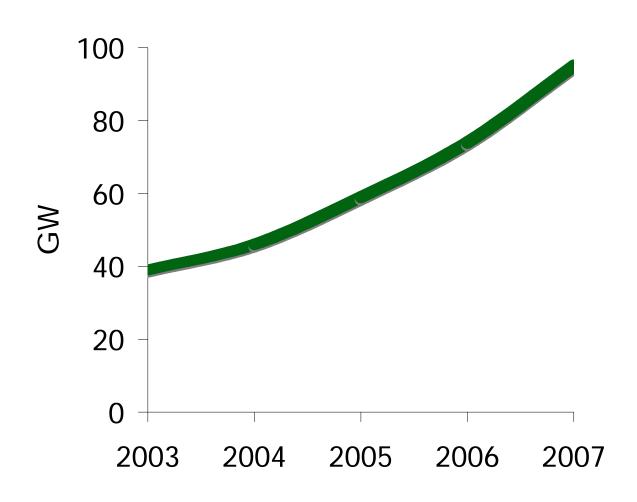

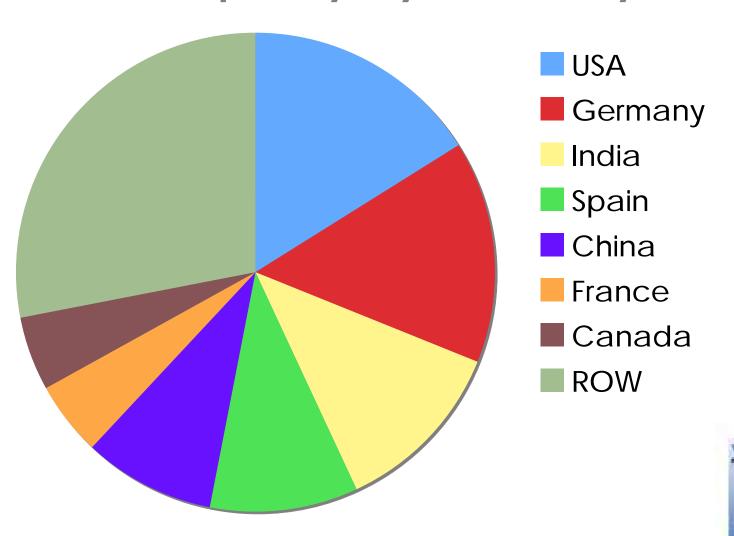


Global Wind Energy Capacity

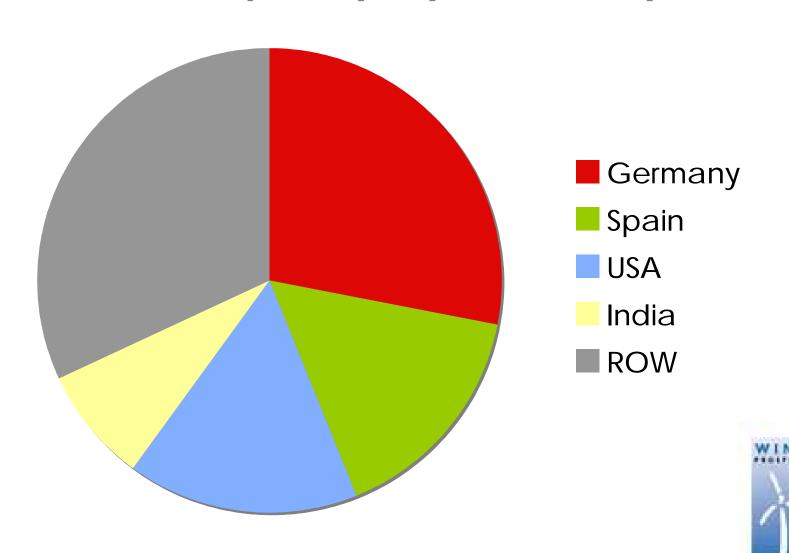




2006 Capacity by Country

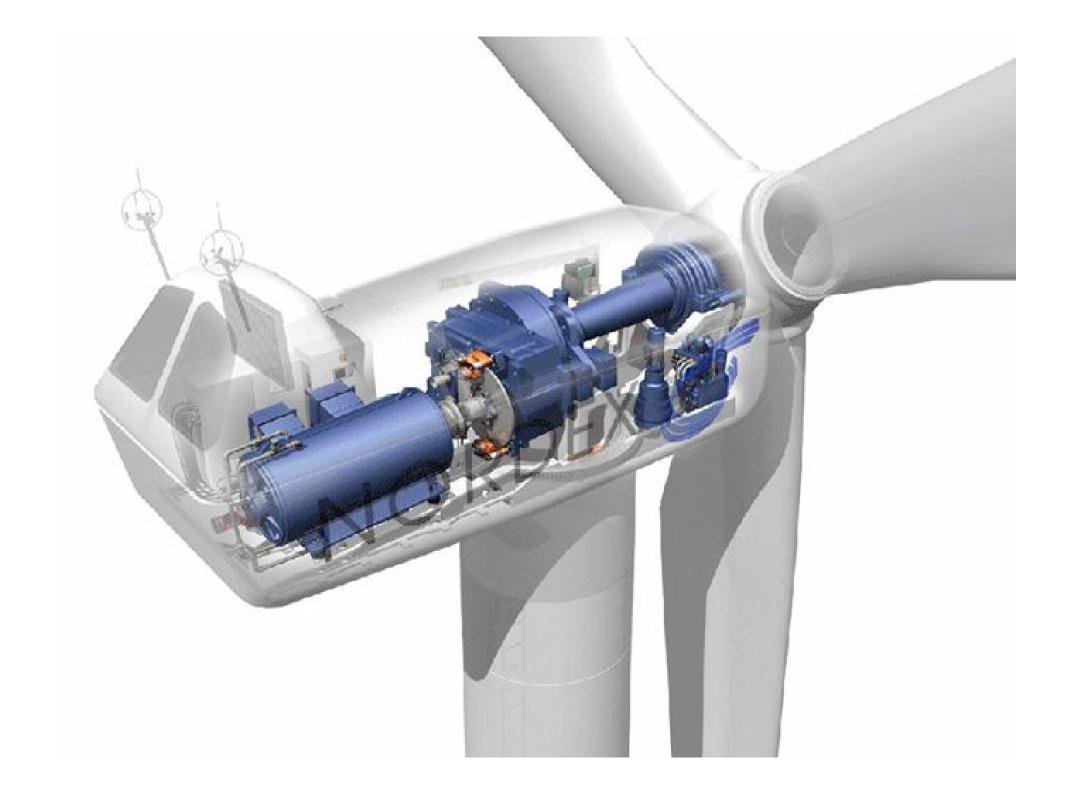

- Incremental advance







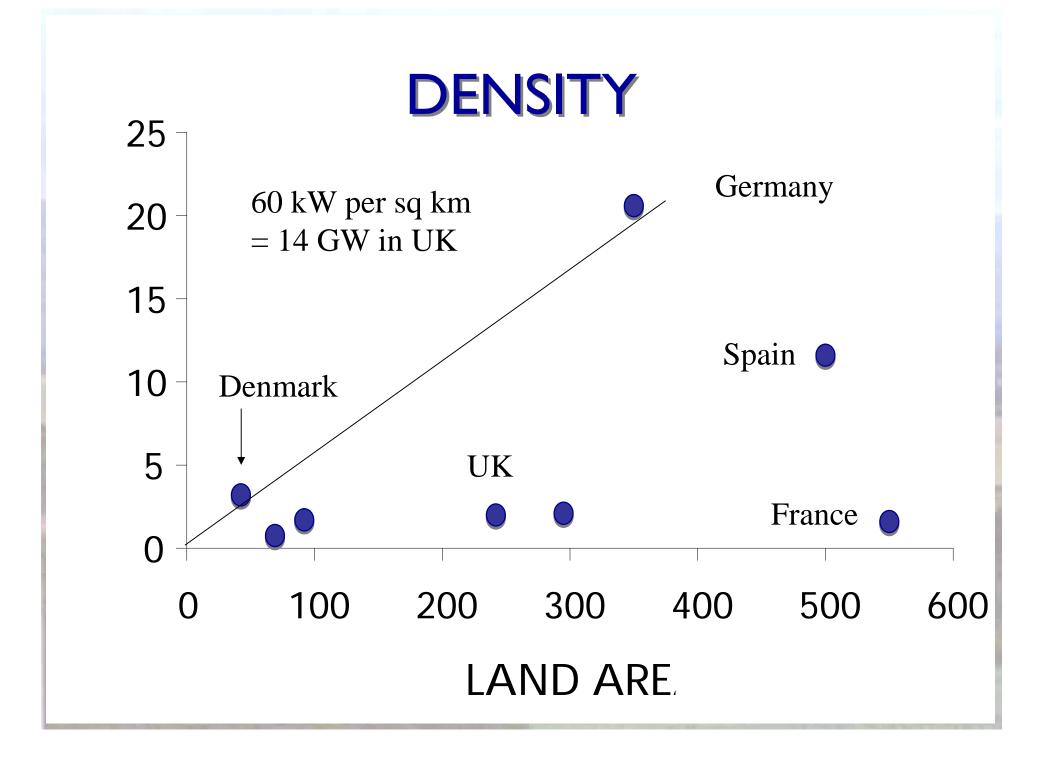
